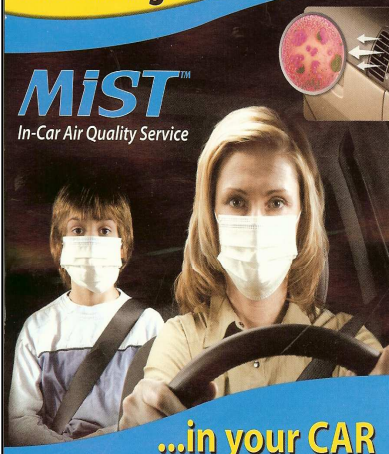

### Brake Fluid : Why Change It ???

Regularly changing the brake fluid in your car allows safer brake operation and can also save you money.

**What is brake fluid?** - It's the life blood of the brake hydraulic system in your car. Brake fluid transfers the pressure you apply on the brake pedal to the brakes and wheels of your car.

**What happens when the brake fluid ages?** - Brake fluid is very hygroscopic, that is, it absorbs moisture very readily. This lowers the boiling point of the fluid and introduces moisture into the components of the braking system.

**How does this affect safety?** - With a lower boiling point, the heat generated from normal braking can cause old brake fluid to boil, which in turn causes a loss of braking pressure or a complete brake failure.

**Replacing your brake fluid improves safety and saves you money:** The moisture in brake fluid causes brake components to corrode internally and these may therefore need replacement earlier than expected. Comparatively the cost of replacing brake fluid is very low.

**How often should brake fluid be replaced?** - We recommend replacing the brake fluid every 2 years. This is in line with most car manufacturer's recommendations. If there is any doubt as to the brake fluid's age, we recommend replacing it.

**Recipe Armenian Nutmeg Cake**

## Armenian Nutmeg Cake

Serve hot as a desert with whipped cream or cold as a cake

120gms Butter or margarine.

2 Cups of brown sugar.

2 Cups Flour. S.R.

1 Egg.

1 Cup Milk.

1 Heaped teaspoon nutmeg.

1 Level teaspoon, bicarbonate of soda.

1 Teaspoon vanilla essence.

100gms. Chopped walnuts or pecan nuts.

Rub butter into the mixture of flour and sugar. Divide mixture in half and spread half in a layer into a well greased cake pan or glass bowl.

Into the other half beat egg and milk plus bicarb, vanilla and nutmeg. Now spoon mixture on top of the other layer and sprinkle the top with nuts.

Bake in preheated oven for about 50–55min. 180°deg.

**Car Care Brakes**



**No Brakes!!!!  
Don't let this happen to you!  
Get your brakes checked.**

The key to efficient braking is matching your driving style and vehicle type with the right brake pad formulation.

Some brake noise is normal, but excessive squeal, grinding or banging means that your brakes need attention.

If you vehicle shakes, vibrates or pulsates when the brakes are applied, then the disc brake rotors may need resurfacing. More serious problems such as a loose component or a faulty steering mechanism can also cause vibration.

We recommend that rotors are machined if they exhibit disc thickness variation, severe scoring, warping or heat damage.
